The <u>City IOF Specific Plan</u> is a proposal to allow drilling up to <u>30</u> new wells in Culver City over a 15 year period.

The <u>Draft Drilling Regulations</u> are "designed to protect the public health, safety, welfare and environment of the city and..."

The <u>draft Environmental Impact Report</u> (EIR) identifies significant environmental effects and possible mitigations

A methane gas leak and flooding prompted authorities to temporarily close the Boneyard, Culver City's dog park. Officials said the gas does not pose a risk to public health or safety.

After an investigation into the cause of the seepage and gas leak, the City demanded that Plains Exploration Production Company (PXP) and Atlantic Oil fix the abandoned well. The companies accepted responsibility and agreed to make repairs.

The Boneyard will remain closed until all repairs are done to the satisfaction of all concerned parties. It was estimated that repairs would

Drilling Mud Release Odor Scenario **Potential Impacts**


Key:

HOW?

We can change the rules -

By making two reasonable and lawful demands:

Demand # 1:

That Culver City Oil & Gas regulations require a minimum of a 2500 foot setback from "sensitive receptors" such as homes, schools, and places where people recreate or worship.


Demand #2:

A minimum of \$2.5 billion dollar surety bond (accident insurance) from a AAA credit rated company for probable cause for any accident or earthquake.

Why?

Oil and Gas Operations use hundreds of hazardous chemicals.

Toxins are released into the air through drilling, operation of diesel or gas powered equipment, and other activities.



Public Health and Safety Risks of Oil and Gas in LA County

By LA County Dept. of Public Health

Focus LA County including the Inglewood Oil Field in our backyard

Over 300 chemicals are used in oil drilling.

→ public health issues if not properly controlled.

Toxic Air Contaminants (TAC)

Nitrogen oxides – NOx

Carbon monoxide - CO

Volatile organic compounds (VOCs)

including Benzene, a known carcinogen

Toluene, ethylbenzene, xylene, hexane, and polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons

Diesel particulate matter (PM2.5 and PM10 - particulate matter with a 10-micron diameter or less)


Particulate Matter

What is airborne PM?

- A mixture of chemicals

Why are we concerned?

- Inhaled and cause a wide range of adverse health impacts
- -Adversely effects climate and ecosystems – warming and cooling



According to the draft EIR under review: Approx. 80% of the <u>cancer risk</u> under the proposed project is from the diesel PM emissions, mostly from well drilling.

- Diesel particulates are also assoc. with health effects including: premature death, heart and lung disease



Documented Health Effects:

- ASTHMA and other Respiratory problems, eye, bloody nose, headaches, and throat irritations,
- Learning Disorders due to endocrine disruptors
- . Cancers, including leukemia

Documented Health Effects (Con't)

Adverse pregnancy/birth outcomes, - miscarriage, preterm births, birth defects Neurologic, gastrointestinal, dermatologic and psychological effects Severe health effects are well documented in the case of disaster events such as spills or explosions
